Open to the public, the series is designed to engage audiences through viewing and scholar-led discussion of documentary films that represent diverse immigration experiences.

The next showing in this series of 6 films, *Between Two Worlds: Identity & Acculturation* will be held at Delaware Valley University Life Sciences Building on January 13th from 3 – 5 pm. *The New Americans Episode 1: The Nigerians* by Steve James chronicles the struggles of an immigrant family as they flee Nigeria because of political violence, wait for years in a refugee camp, and finally adapt to life in a low-income housing project as they work to pursue the American Dream.
