Angel is living with her grandparents. Her mother is living in another town and visits her once a week. She was abandoned by her father since she was born. Her aunt, Maricel Collados, 23 years old, works as a Highschool Teacher and earns \$418 monthly. Her aunt's income usually spent on food, utilities and education. Angel has been in the area for 9 years now. They are living in their own house. The house is built with G.I Sheets for the roof, cemented walls and cemented floorings that is in good condition. It has 2 rooms with 1 window. They use electricity as source of light. The family is able to eat three meals a day with rice, fish and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from spring which is shared with their neighbors and use firewood for cooking. The family has their own water sealed toilet and their household garbage is disposed through burning.

Like any other Filipino family, the Collados family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having the child's complete education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly, increase their income.

PSBP, together with the community, implements programs in health, education and psychosocial development and protection that benefit the children, their families and communities in the area. We hope that through the PSBP sponsorship program, the Collados family could take part in our programs.
