Sean is living with his mother and other siblings. His father is working as a truck helper in Manila and only comes home once every 3 months and supports the family by sending \$20-52 weekly. Sean has been in the area for 10 years now. They are living in a borrowed house which is owned by his grandparents. The house is built with G.I Sheets for the roof, cemented walls and cemented floorings that is in good condition. It has 3 rooms with 5 windows. They use electricity as source of light. The family is able to eat three meals a day with rice, fish and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from their own water pipe and use gas stove for cooking. The family has their own water sealed toilet and their household garbage is disposed through government disposal system.

Like any other Filipino family, the Juayong family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having the child's complete education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly, increase their income.


