Reymark is living with his parents. His father, Ronald Canduli, 38 years old, works as a construction worker and earns \$100-110 monthly. His mother, Mariefriend Canduli, 28 years old is a housewife. It has 2 rooms with 2 windows. They use electricity as source of light. The family is able to eat three meals a day with rice, fish and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from their own spring and use firewood for cooking. The family uses shared water sealed toilet and their household garbage is disposed compost pit.

Like any other Filipino family, the Canduli family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having the child's complete education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly, increase their income.


