Eyeng, is an active and healthy grade 5 student at Boton Elementary School, a government owned school which is located 1 kilometer from her residence. She rides a jeepney & tricycle from home going to and from her school. She is an average student and dreams of becoming a Doctor someday.

Eyeng loves to play jumping rope, hide-and-seek and other outdoor activities with her friends in the neighborhood but due to pandemic she only stays at home to play for now. She also enjoys drawing, singing and dancing. At home, she helps in washing the dishes, cleaning the house and running simple errands.

Eyeng's mother died because of breast cancer last February 2014. She is living with her father and sibling. Her father, Francis Anduyan, 45 years old, works as a Construction worker and earns \$126 monthly. Her father's income usually spent on food, utilities and education. Eyeng has been in the area for 11 years now. They are living in a borrowed house which is owned by her grandparents. The house is built with G.I Sheets for the roof, cemented walls and bamboo floorings that needs repair. It has 1 multipurpose room with 1 window. They use electricity as source of light. The family is able to eat three meals a day with rice, fish and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from their own water pipe and use gas stove for cooking. The family has their own water sealed toilet and their household garbage is disposed of through government waste disposal system.

Like any other Filipino family, the Anduyan family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having the child's complete education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly, increase their income.


