Tay Dang Orphanage

Dear PSBI Sponsor,

On behalf of the Pearl S. Buck International and our Country Office in Vietnam, we are very pleased to introduce Giang and his foster family to you. It is called foster family as Giang lives in an orphanage that cares for orphans and displaced children. He was born in 2009. He has no mother and father and often wanders in the street. He suffers from mental disorder so we could not find any information about him and his family. Thanks to a Social Staff, he was turned over to the orphanage on 7th March 2018 when he was 9 years old. Then Giang is taken into the orphanage and he has been living there ever since then.

Giang is now nearly 13 years old with a height of 3'94'' and a weight of 48 lbs. At present, his health is in good condition thanks to the nursing of housemothers and staffs. He is unable to speak and has attention deficit hyperactivity disorder. Because of his Dow syndrome, he is now attending a class to learn basic skills at the orphanage. In his free time, he often watches cartoon and plays with his foster siblings in the orphanage.

Established in 1984 on an area of 1.5 hectare in Tay Dang, Ba Vi district, Hanoi which is approximately 45 km away from the downtown of Hanoi, Tay Dang Orphanage is a big house for 41 orphans living in two 2-storey buildings with necessary facilities such as fans, wardrobes and beds. The children can play sports on a very big play ground equipped with sport and recreation facilities in their free time. Monthly support from the Government to children in Tay Dang is currently on average of USD 63.00 per child. This limited amount is not enough to cover nutritional expenses for the children with 3 frugal meals per day. To supplement daily meals, the children plant different kinds of vegetables and fruits on a large garden and raise domestic animals and fowls at the back of the center. Despite of difficulties, the orphanage has been trying its best to seek for external support funding sources and generous sponsors to meet the basic needs and improve living and education conditions for those disadvantaged children. Tay Dang Orphanage highly appreciates charity and donation from interested organizations and individuals to support the children.

With support from the Tay Dang Orphanage, Giang is very happy to share his life at the orphanage with you. We hope that you will establish an everlasting and meaningful relationship with him and the rest of the children at the orphanage through your sponsorship commitment. Thank you for your generosity and kindness.
