At home, she helps in different household chores such like washing dishes, washing clothes, cooking and running simple errands.

Marie, lives with her both parents. Her Raymond Catarining, works as a Construction Worker and earns \$240 per month. While her mother stays at home taking care of the family. Their earnings usually spent on food, utilities and education. I would like to introduce the other member of the family:

Marie has been in the area for 12 years now. They live in their own house. The house is built with G.I Sheets and plywood for the roof, plywood for the walls and earthen and cement for the flooring and in needs of repair. It has 1 room and 2 windows which provide for the ventilation of the house. They use electricity as source of light. The family able to eat three meals a day with rice, fish and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from pipe which they shared and use firewood for cooking. The family uses a water-sealed type of toilet and their household garbage is disposed of through government waste disposal system.

Like any other Filipino family, the Catarining family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parent dream of having the child's complete education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly, increase their income.


