Kaye is in good health and did not suffer any major illness this past year. She is an active 3rd grader student at Northville 15 Integrated School, a government school located 3 kilometers from their residence. She rides a tricycle in going to and from her school. Her performance in school is average and she dreams of becoming an Teacher someday.

As a young child, Kaye loves to play. She likes to play hacky sack, jumping rope, race and other outdoor activities with her friends. Some of her favorite hobby is dancing. More than just enjoying his childhood through playing and doing his recreational activities, she helps in the daily household chores as well like sweeping the backyard and running errands during his spare time.

Kaye lives with her grandmother. Her parents are separated and doesn't receive any support from them. Her grandmother doesn't have a permanent income since her primary work is Caretaker of the house of their relatives and in exchange, they received free food, free lodging and other support from the relatives. Their earnings are usually spent on basic necessities like food, education, utilities and medicines. I would like to introduce to you the other members of the family:

The family has been in the area for more than 7 years now. They live in their borrowed house from a relative as a Caretaker. Their house is built with G.I Sheets for the roof and cement for the floor and walls and in needs of repair. It has 2 rooms and 2 windows which provide for the ventilation of the house. They are privileged to be provided with the basic utilities like electricity and water supply. The family eats three meals a day with rice, fish and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from a pipe (gripa) which they shared with the neighborhood and use a gas stove for cooking. The family uses a water-sealed type of toilet and their household garbage is disposed of through government waste disposal system.

Like any other Filipino family, the Fabiala family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having their children complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly, increase their income.


