Lianne is in good health and did not suffer any major illness this past year. She is an active 1st grader student at Muzon Pabahay Elementary School Subic, a government school located 500 meters from their residence. She walks in going to and from her school. Her performance in school is above average. She dreams of becoming a Teacher someday.

As a young child, Lianne loves to play. She likes to play hide-and-seek, toys, piko with her friends. Some of her favorite hobby is dancing and drawing. More than just enjoying her childhood through playing and doing her recreational activities, she helps in the daily household chores as well like cleaning the house and running errands during her spare time.

Lianne lives with her Family. Her Father, Jeffrey Soliman, 43 years old, works as a Truck Helper and earns \$130 a month while her mother stays at home to take care the needs of the family. Their earnings are usually spent on basic necessities like food, education, utilities and medicines. I would like to introduce to you the other members of the family:

The family has been in the area for more than 6 years now. They live in their own house under the property of the government. Their house is built with G.I Sheets for the roof and cement for the floor and walls and in needs of repair. It has 1 multi-purpose room and 2 windows which provide for the ventilation of the house. They are privileged to be provided with the basic utilities like electricity and water supply. The family eats three meals a day with rice, fish and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from a piped water (gripa) which they shared with their neighborhood and use a super kalan for cooking. The family uses a water-sealed type of toilet and their household garbage is disposed of through government waste disposal system.

Like any other Filipino family, the Soliman family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having their children complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly, increase their income.




Lianne and her family look forward to communicating with you in English to share important family events in the future.
