Dear Sponsor,

On behalf of Pearl S. Buck Foundation (Thailand), we are pleased to introduce you to Surapong Wichai-udomporn, and his family. He was born on September 25, 2015. He is now 6 years old. He stands 3'11" cm and weighs 46.30 lbs. He is a Karen boy, his nickname is Su-kue. He is a Buddhist boy who speaks Karen dialect.

Su-kue and family lives in a small village named Ban Huay Kha-noon village, a high land village located away from Mae Ramard district. Most of community people are Karen hill tribes (Kapagayaw), consisting children, working age persons, and elderly persons. Main occupation of people are agriculturists who grow rice and corn, as well as collect wild things for selling with low and uncertain income. Health problems found in community are children's malnutrition, cold, pneumonia, and diarrhea. Villagers are Buddhists and Christians, while some of them still believe in spirits.

Su-kue is in good health and has received receiving vaccinations per schedules. In generally, he is healthy and strong. He got sick sometimes when weather changed, but got well in short time after taking enough resting and medicines received from healthcare center. Su-kue and family are benefited from government healthcare insurance program.

Su-kue is a cute, polite, diligent, and cheerful boy. He is studying in grade 1 at Ban Huay Kha-noon School, a public school. It is around 1 km from his home to school. He goes to school and back home by walking with friends. He is benefited from school free lunch program for students. He has good developments. He likes to learn new things and join activities with his teacher and friends. He loves friends and can get along well with them. Physical education is his favorite subject. He wishes to be a police when he grows up. Green is his favorite color. In free time he enjoys running for fun and playing games with his friends. He helps to wash dishes and sweep floor at home.

Your generous support is needed for Su-kue as it will assist him to have more readiness in studying, and more willpower in paying good attention in studying continuously to graduate from high educational level for better future of himself and his family. Hi family is very poor, his parents earn very few and uncertain income per year that is not enough to cover family's living cost and his education expenses. Without your kind support Su-kue may decide to drop schooling before he completes compulsory level in order to help his parents working in the field to earn income for supporting whole family.

Su-kue's father, Mr. Sirisak, is 29 years old. His mother, Miss. Supaporn, is 24 years old. The family grows rice for family consumption and grows corn for selling. They earn low and uncertain income around USD 1,000 (USD 1=30 Baht) per year from selling corn crops. Su-kue's older brother, Arnon, is 8 years old and studying in grade 2 at the same school as him. Everyone in family is in good health. They live simply and happily together.

The family lives in small one storey half wooden and half bamboo house with leaved roof built high above the ground on public land. The house belongs to Su-kue's maternal grandparents. It is one open room house, one corner of it was set as kitchen. They have hygienic toilet. Their house is surrounded by shady trees, and there is a large space for children to play. The house has no electricity. The family uses water from mountain water supply system for consumption and boiled water for drinking. They cook rice and foods by using firewood. Household garbage is disposed by burning several meters away from their house.

Like any other Thai family, Su-kue's family wishes to improve their quality of life. They dream of having their school age family members complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house and most importantly increase their income.

Su-kue and family need assistance and your sponsorship will make a difference in their lives. Your support will usher in new hope and confidence in the family as they work together for a brighter future. We commit to facilitate a family development process for this family so they achieve lasting improvement in their lives. Our foundation implements programs on **Health, Education, Livelihood and Psycho-social** development from which the family can benefit. We do this through the hand-up approach of partnership so families develop their self-help abilities to learn building up what they can do with a little assistance, motivation and inspiration from kind sponsors like you.

Su-kue is still too young to write so his mother, Miss. Supaporn, looks forward to writing to you in Thai language (original letters will be attached with English translation letters), and sharing important and interesting family events with you and your family in future.
