At her age, Ina doesn't play many games aside from racing. She enjoys drawing anime, singing Ariana Grande's songs, and reading novel series like The 39 Clues. She also helps with household chores like washing dishes, cleaning the house, and running errands.

The family has been in the area for more than 11 years now. They rent the house and lot where they live. The house is built with G.I. sheets for the roof, and cement for the floor, and walls. The house is in good condition. It has 2 bedrooms and 5 windows which provide for the ventilation of the house. The family is privileged to be provided with basic utilities like electricity, and water supply. They use a gas stove for cooking and eat three meals a day with rice, fish, and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from the pipe water and use a water-sealed type of toilet. Their household garbage is disposed of through the government waste disposal system.

Like any other Filipino family, the Andrin family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having their children complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house, and most importantly, increase their income.

PSBP, together with the community, has implemented programs in health, education, and psycho-social development and protection that benefit the children, their families, and their communities. We hope that the Andrin family will be a part of our programs.
