They call her Eunica as her nickname. She has a younger brother. She has brown skin, is 4 feet and 5 1/2 inches tall, and weighs 25 kilos. She was baptized as a Roman Catholic.

Eunica is in good health and did not suffer from any major illness this past year. She is an active 4th-grade student at Iram Elementary School, a government school located 250 meters away from their residence. She walks in going to and from her school. Her favorite subject is Good Manners and Right Conduct and her favorite school activity is during their gardening time. She dreams of becoming a teacher someday.

During her spare time, Eunica plays volleyball, jumping rope, hide and seek, toys, races, and, a playhouse. She also enjoys drawing games, singing Lady Gaga songs, watching variety shows, reading school books and the bible, dancing to TikTok tunes, and planting vegetables. At a young age, she knows a lot of household chores like washing clothes, washing the dishes, fetching water, babysitting, cleaning the house, sweeping the backyard, cooking, and running simple errands.

Eunica lives with her mother, stepfather, and half-brother. Her biological father left them when she was still in the womb of her mother. Her stepfather, Arnold Ebidag, 29 years old, works as a construction worker and earns \$160 monthly which is usually spent on necessities like food, education, utilities, and medicines. The family has been in the area for more than 10 years now. They share the house and lot where they live with her relatives. The house is built with G.I. sheets for the roof and cement for the floor and walls. The house is in good condition. It has 1 bedroom and 2 windows which provide for the ventilation of the house. The family is privileged to be provided with basic utilities like electricity, and water supply. They use a gas stove and charcoal fuelled stove for cooking and eat three meals a day with rice, fish, and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from the spring which they share with their relatives and use a water-sealed type of toilet which they share with their relatives as well. Their household garbage is disposed of through the government waste disposal system.

Like any other Filipino family, the Badar family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having their children complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house, and most importantly, increase their income.


