They call him Bing-Bing as his nickname. He is the eldest of three siblings. He is moreno, 4 feet and 10 inches tall, and weighs 47 kilos. He was baptized as a Roman Catholic.

Bing-Bing is in good health and did not suffer from any major illness this past year. He is an active 5th-grade student at Iram High School, a government school located 250 meters from their residence. He walks in going to and from his school. His favorite subject is Science and his favorite activity in school is by joining the school's student council. He dreams of becoming a policeman someday.

During his spare time, Bing-Bing plays basketball, jumping rope, *tumbang preso*, computer games, *patintero*, hide and seek, some toys, playhouse, race, and *piko*. He also enjoys drawing houses, singing Lukas Graham's 7 Years, dancing to school activities, watching vlogs, reading school books, and planting vegetables. He is an all-around boy, as he does almost every chore at home.

Bing-Bing lives with his family and stepfather. His biological father passed away on April 23, 2021, because of a severe ulcer. His stepfather, Erwin Laurel, 36 years old, works as a fisherman and earns \$240 a month which is usually spent on necessities like food, education, utilities, and medicines. The family has been in the area for more than 4 years now. They borrow the house and lot where they live. The house is built with G.I. sheets for the roof and cement for the floor and walls. The house is in good condition. It has 1 bedroom and 5 windows which provide for the ventilation of the house. The family is privileged to be provided with basic utilities like electricity, and water supply. They use a gas stove for cooking and eat three meals a day with rice, fish, and vegetables being the usual combination. They get their water from the spring which they share with their relatives and use a water-sealed type of toilet. Their household garbage is disposed of through burning waste.

Like any other Filipino family, the Mantolino family wishes to improve their quality of life. The parents dream of having their children complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house, and most importantly, increase their income.


