Fundang is currently in sixth grade at Dapdap Elementary School - SY 2023-2024, which is 450 meters away from her home. She walks daily to and from her school. Filipino is her favorite subject, and she loves playing badminton. Her aspiration is to become a teacher in the future.

During her leisure time, Fundang engages in various activities such as jumping rope, playing tumbang preso, hide and seek, patintero, and piko. Additionally, she enjoys dancing to TikTok tunes. Apart from these, she assists with daily chores, including washing dishes, cleaning the house, sweeping the yard, and running errands.

Fundang lives with her mother, siblings, and other relatives. Her parents separated in 2020, and since then, her brother Mharon Lupanggo (24) has been the sole provider for the family. He works as a construction worker and earns \$200 per month, which is just enough to cover their necessary expenses such as education, food, utilities, and medicine. Despite their modest income, Fundang and her family are able to manage their expenses and live a decent life.

The Cunanan family has been living in their current house with their paternal grandmother for 12 years. The house is in good condition, with cement walls and floors and a G.I. sheet roof. It has two bedrooms and four windows, which provide good ventilation. The family is fortunate to have access to basic utilities such as electricity and water supply. They use a charcoal stove for cooking and have three meals a day consisting of rice, fish, and vegetables. They get their water from a piped water source and have a water-sealed toilet. They dispose of household waste through the government's waste disposal system.


