Pearl S. Buck – Bridging Cultures Through Literature

The Nobel Prize in Literature 1938: awarded "for her rich and truly epic descriptions of peasant life in China and for her biographical masterpieces".

Cultural influence: played a key role in bridging Eastern and Western cultures through her writing.

Social activist: focused on issues such as women's rights, racial equality, and humanitarian efforts.


