Yanah is currently studying in the second grade at Ipil Central School, which is located 1200 meters away from her house. She commutes to and from school every day by riding a tricycle. Her favorite subject is Filipino, while her most enjoyable school event is the Christmas party. In the future, she hopes to become a nurse.

Yanah enjoys various activities during her leisure time, such as playing hide and seek, playing with toys, racing games, patintero, badminton, drawing butterflies, singing "Angel like You," dancing to TikTok tunes, and reading Filipino storybooks. Additionally, she helps with household chores by cleaning the house, washing dishes, and running errands.

Yanah's family consists of her father, Clemente Garjas Jr. (48), who works as a tricycle driver and earns \$160 a month, her mother, Edna Garjas (48), who occasionally sells barbecue and earns \$60 a month, and her second eldest brother, Barry Garjas (25), who is a merchandiser and earns \$200 monthly. The family members work hard to support each other's needs, and most of their earnings go towards education, food, utilities, and medicine.

They use a gas stove for cooking and typically have three meals a day consisting of rice, fish, and vegetables. The family gets their water from a piped water system and has a water-sealed toilet. They use a government disposal system for household waste.
