Her mother, Astrind Nuqui, aged 33, works as a house helper and earns \$165 a month. Despite their modest income, they are able to cover necessary expenses such as education, food, utilities, and medicine.


The Nuqui family has been residing in their current home for over five years. Their house requires repairs, with sturdy cement walls, floors, and a G.I. sheet roof. It features two bedrooms and three windows providing ample ventilation for the family, along with access to basic utilities such as electricity and water supply. They use a gas stove for cooking and obtain their water from a piped source. Household waste is disposed of through the government's waste disposal system to maintain environmental cleanliness.

Similar to other Filipino families, the Nuqui family aspires to complete their education, maintain good health, keep their house tidy and organized, and increase their income. Our established programs aim to promote health, education, and psychosocial development in the community. We strongly urge the Nuqui family to participate in these programs, as they offer new opportunities and open doors to a brighter future.
