Eligibility:

- Express an interest in furthering their knowledge and leadership skills.
- Commit to 100% attendance at all sessions.
- Receive one recommendation from their principal, teacher or counselor and another adult submitted to sfreise@pearlsbuck.org.
- In grades 9-11 as of June 2025.

Applications will be reviewed and processed in the order they are received. Please submit your completed application to us by **May 16**, **2025**. PSBI requires two (2) references from people who are not your parent/guardian or a relative. Please send the reference form to each reference and ask them to complete it before the application deadline.

Students will be notified of acceptance by June 1, 2025.
