On behalf of Pearl S. Buck Foundation (Thailand), we are pleased to introduce you to Lallabell Kenprajong and her family. Lallabell was born on May 14, 2018. She is now 7 years old. She stands 3'9" and weighs 39.68 lbs. Lallabell who is fondly call "Chabell", is a Thai and Buddhist girl. She can speak both Thai language and Northeastern dialect.

Chabell and family live in Ban Gud-ra-ngum village, a small village located around 6 km from Warinchamrab district, and around 10 km from Ubon Ratchathani province. Some part of this village is slope area while some part is low land area situated around 2 km from Mool River, the main river of northeastern part of our country. There are 3 seasons, the temperature in summer is around 35-40 degree Celsius, it is around 10-15 degree Celsius in winter. There are flooding conditions occur around 20% of the village area in rainy season, especially in the low slope area near the river. There are around 967 populations or around 246 households in this village. It is convenient for people in traveling from the village to other places by motorcycles and buses. Most of villagers are children and working age persons. Since this village is in animal raising and military areas, the families cannot own the land, so they have no arable land and have only house building area. Main occupation of community members is general worker, average family annual income is around USD 2,500.- (USD 1=Baht 30). There is a public school and 1 Buddhist temple in this village. There is a public sub-district health promotion hospital located around 3 km from this village. Health problems found in this village are children's malnutrition caused of inappropriate physical developments per ages as well as physical and mental disabilities, seasonal diseases such as hemorrhagic fever, drug addiction problems, chronic diseases problems of the elderly persons i.e. high blood pressure and diabetes.

Chabell is healthy, and has received vaccinations per schedules. She has good developments the same as other children. She eats 3 meals per day cooked by her mother. Chabell and family are benefited from government health insurance program.

Chabell is a lovely, polite, cheerful, diligent, and talkative girl. She is studying in grade 2 at a public school named Ban Gud-ra-ngum School, located around 800 m from her home. She goes to school and back home by motorcycle with her step grandfather. She receives USD 0.33 as daily allowance to school. She is benefited from school free lunch program for students. She is also benefited from School Farm Project to Help Unhealthy Children and Project To Support Laying Hens for Sustainable Income Generation to School and Households in Ban Gud-ra-ngum village supported by our foundation. She can study and learn things in the good level. She likes to study and pays good attention in it. Thai language is her favorite subject. She wishes to be a doctor when she grows up. She can get along well with all friends. She likes to help with school's activities. She helps her family to do house works such as to wash dishes, and sweep floor. Black is her favorite color. Volleyball is her favorite sport. In free time she likes to draw & color pictures, run for fun, and play games with friends.

Your generous support is needed for Chabell as it will assist her to have more readiness in studying, and more willpower in paying good attention in studying continuously to graduate from high educational level for better future of herself and her family. Her family is very poor, earns very few and uncertain income per year that is not enough to cover family's living cost and children's education expenses. Without your kind support Chabell may decide to drop schooling before she completes compulsory level in order to help her family working to earn income for supporting whole family.

Chabell's parents went to work as workers in another province. They send cash support around USD 166.66 per month to pay for family living costs and expenses of their 3 children. Chabell's grandmother, Mrs. Samrong, is 75 years old, unhealthy with diabetes, high blood pressure, and Hypercholesterolemia. She has to see doctor for medical treatments and receiving medicines every 3 months, it costs her around USD 6.66-10 for transportation fares and meals per time. Her step grandfather, Mr. Kampee, is 66 years old. Grandparents cannot work because they are too old to work. Both of them receive social welfare allowance for elderly persons around USD 43.33 per month. Chabell's oldest brother, Natthawat, is 15 years old and studying in grade 10. Her older brother, Natthagorn, is 13 years old and studying in grade 8. They study at a public school located in the district. It costs them around USD 100 per month for transportation fares, meals, and school supplies.

The family has lived in this community for many years. They stay in one story half wooden and concrete house with zinc roof. Their house is in moderate condition. It has one bed room, one opened room, kitchen, and one bathroom. Grandmother owns the house legally. The house has electricity and is furnished with old television, electric fan, and light bulbs. There is village water supply system for using, they buy filter water bottles for drinking around USD 4-6 per month. Household garbage is disposed by burning several meters away from their home.

Like any other Thai family, Chabell's family wishes to improve their quality of life. They dream of having their school age family members complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house, and most importantly increase their income.

Chabell and her family need assistance, and your kind sponsorship will make a difference in their lives. Your support will usher in new hope and confidence in the family as they work together for a brighter future. Our foundation commits to facilitate a family development process for this family so they achieve lasting improvement in their lives. We implement programs on **H**ealth, **E**ducation, **L**ivelihood and **P**sychosocial developments from which her family can benefit. We do this through the handed-up approach of partnership so families develop their self-help abilities to learn in building up what they can do with a little assistance, motivation and inspiration from generous sponsors like you.

Chabell looks forward to communicating with you in Thai language (original letters will be attached with English translation letters), and sharing important family events with you and family in the future.
