Tay Dang Orphanage

Dear PSBI Sponsor,

On behalf of the Pearl S. Buck International and our Country Office in Vietnam, we are very pleased to introduce Kieu Ngoc Anh and her foster family to you. It is called foster family as Kieu Ngoc Anh lives in an orphanage that cares for orphans and displaced children. Kieu Ngoc Anh was born in January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 in Bo De Pagoda, Long Bien district, Ha Noi. She was born in a family with difficult circumstances so she was taken into Bo De Pagoda. After that, she was brought to Tay Dang Orphanage by social staff on the 5<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and she has been living there ever since then.

Kieu Ngoc Anh is now 13 years old with a height of 5'20" and a weight of 105 lbs. Thanks to housemothers' caring, she has been in good health condition. Up to now, she has been in grade 8<sup>th</sup> at Tay Dang Secondary School, which is 2 kilometers far from the orphanage. Therefore, she goes to school by bicycle every day. Among of subject, she is most interested in Maths, Literature while she has no interest in English. She studies hard so she has got good academic grade. In the future, she would like to become a chief and she wants to work in beauty field such as makeup or nails art. In her free time, she often plays badminton and traditional folk games, read books, and watches shows about beauty and cuisine on TV. Kieu Ngoc Anh also takes part in school activities, such as Life Skills Education program on School Violence Prevention and the Vietnam Book Day (April 21<sup>st</sup>) event with the theme "Good Books – Good Readers. In the orphanage, she helps housemother with cooking, washing dishes and cleaning her room.

Established in 1984 on an area of 1.5 hectare in Tay Dang, Ba Vi district, Hanoi which is approximately 45 km away from the downtown of Hanoi, Tay Dang Orphanage is a big house for 36 orphans living in two 2-storey buildings with necessary facilities such as fans, wardrobes and beds. The children can play sports on a very big play ground equipped with sport and recreation facilities in their free time. Monthly support from the Government to children in Tay Dang is currently on average of USD 63 per child. This limited amount is not enough to cover nutritional expenses for the children with 3 frugal meals per day. To supplement daily meals, the children plant different kinds of vegetables and fruits on a large garden and raise domestic animals and fowls at the back of the center. Despite of difficulties, the orphanage has been trying its best to seek for external support funding sources and generous sponsors to meet the basic needs and improve living and education conditions for those disadvantaged children. Tay Dang Orphanage highly appreciates charity and donation from interested organizations and individuals to support the children.

With support from the Tay Dang Orphanage, Kieu Ngoc Anh is very happy to share her life at the orphanage with you. We hope that you will establish an everlasting and meaningful relationship with her and the rest of the children at the orphanage through your sponsorship commitment. Thank you for your generosity and kindness.
