Dear PSBI Sponsor,

On behalf of the Pearl S. Buck International and our Country Office in Vietnam, we are very pleased to introduce Kieu Nhi Anh and her foster family to you. It is called foster family as Kieu Nhi Anh lives in an orphanage that cares for orphans and displaced children. Kieu Nhi Anh was born in 6<sup>th</sup> January 2012 in Hanoi city. She was abandoned by her parents at Bo De Pagoda in Hanoi since birth. Then, she was raised by the pagoda. Because the pagoda was too crowded, Nhi Anh was brought to Tay Dang Orphanage in January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and she has been living there ever since then.

Kieu Nhi Anh is now 12 years old with a height of 4'55'' and a weight of 80 lbs. Thanks to housemothers' caring, she has been in good health condition. Currently, she is studying in grade 7<sup>th</sup> at Tay Dang Secondary School, which is 2 kilometers far from the orphanage. Therefore, she goes to school by bicycle every day. Among of subject, she is good at Physical Education while she has no interest in Math as it is very difficult. In the future, she would like to become a hairdresser. In her free time, she often plays folk games and badminton with her foster siblings. Sometimes, she helps housemother with household chore like sweeping the floor and tidying the rooms.

Established in 1984 on an area of 1.5 hectare in Tay Dang, Ba Vi district, Hanoi which is approximately 60 km away from the downtown of Hanoi, Tay Dang Orphanage is a big house for 35 orphans living in two 2-storey buildings with necessary facilities such as fans, wardrobes and beds. The children can play sports on a very big play ground equipped with sport and recreation facilities in their free time. Monthly support from the Government to children in Tay Dang is currently on average of USD 85.00 per child. This limited amount is not enough to cover nutritional expenses for the children with 3 frugal meals per day. To supplement daily meals, the children plant different kinds of vegetables and fruits on a large garden and raise domestic animals and fowls at the back of the center. Despite of difficulties, the orphanage has been trying its best to seek for external support funding sources and generous sponsors to meet the basic needs and improve living and education conditions for those disadvantaged children. Tay Dang Orphanage highly appreciates charity and donation from interested organizations and individuals to support the children.

With support from the Tay Dang Orphanage, Kieu Nhi Anh is very happy to share her life at the orphanage with you. We hope that you will establish an everlasting and meaningful relationship with her and the rest of the children at the orphanage through your sponsorship commitment. Thank you for your generosity and kindness.
