On behalf of Pearl S. Buck Foundation (Thailand), we are pleased to introduce you to Patcharee Sagula and her family. Patcharee was born on March 23, 2010. She is now 15 years old. She stands 5'3" and weighs 85.98 lbs. Patcharee who is fondly call "Sroi", is a Thai and Buddhist girl. She can speak both Thai language and Northeastern dialect.

Sroi and family live in a small community in Det-udom district, Ubon Ratchathani province. The community is surrounded by rice fields. There are around 100 households in this community. Most of people are agriculturists who earn main income from selling rice crops and vegetables. Some villagers go to work in other places for extra income after harvesting season. There are temple and school located in this community.

Sroi is healthy, and had received vaccinations per schedules. She has good developments the same as other children. She eats 3 meals per day cooked by her mother. Sroi and family are benefited from government health insurance program.

Sroi is a lovely, polite, cheerful, talkative, and responsible girl. She is studying in grade 10 at a public school named Na Suang Witaya School, located around 8 km from her home. She goes to school and back home by a hired car with other students. She receives USD 1.66 (USD 1=Baht 30) as daily allowance to school. She is benefited from school free lunch program for students. She can study in the good level. She got G.P.A. 3.50 from last semester exams. She likes to study and pays good attention in it. English is her favorite subject. She wishes to be a teacher when she grows up. She helps her family to do house works such as to wash dishes, clean house, and wash clothes. White is her favorite color. Running race is her favorite sport. In free time she likes read books, listen to songs, draw and color pictures.

Your generous support is needed for Sroi as it will assist her to have more readiness in studying, and more willpower in paying good attention in studying continuously to graduate from high educational level for better future of herself and her family. Her family is very poor, her parents earn very few and uncertain income per year that is not enough to cover family's living cost and children's education expenses. Without your kind support Sroi may decide to drop schooling before she completes compulsory level in order to help her mother and older sister working to earn income for supporting whole family.

Sroi's parents separated since she was young. Her father has neither visited nor provided cash support to family. Her mother, Miss. Sukornkid, is 55 years old. She is unhealthy with HIV Infected and cervical cancer, she has to see doctor for health checkup and receiving medicines every 2 months. She earns very low and uncertain income around USD 1.66-3.33 per month from collecting and buying used things for selling in the village. She also receives social welfare allowance for HIV infected person around USD 20 per month. Sroi's older sister, Miss. Pennapa, is 34 years old, and healthy. She earns low and uncertain income around USD 166.66-200.00 per month as a daily worker. She has to support her son, Thanawut, who is 12 years old and studying in grade 7, so she can provide cash support to her mother and younger sister not much.

The family has lived in this community for many years. They stay in one storey concrete house with zinc roof belongs to a cousin of Sroi' aunt. It has 2 bedrooms, one opened room, one kitchen, and one bathroom. The surrounding is quite pleasant with no pollution. There is also a large space for children to play in the community. They grow vegetables in the house's area. The house has electricity and is furnished with 1 electric iron, 1 electric fan, 1 electric rice cooker, and light bulbs. There is clean water from water supply system for using, and rain water kept in jars for drinking. Household garbage is disposed by burning several meters away from their home.

Like any other Thai family, Sroi's family wishes to improve their quality of life. They dream of having their school age family members complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house, and most importantly increase their income.

Sroi and her family need assistance, and your kind sponsorship will make a difference in their lives. Your support will usher in new hope and confidence in the family as they work together for a brighter future. Our foundation commits to facilitate a family development process for this family so they achieve lasting improvement in their lives. We implement programs on **Health, Education, Livelihood and Psycho-social** developments from which her family can benefit. We do this through the handed-up approach of partnership so families develop their self-help abilities to learn in building up what they can do with a little assistance, motivation and inspiration from generous sponsors like you.
