



# ***FAMILY INTRODUCTION SHEET FROM THAILAND***

Dear Sponsor,

On behalf of Pearl S. Buck Foundation (Thailand), we are pleased to introduce you to Thanyatsep Lengsit and his family. Thanyatsep was born on October 31, 2016. He is now 8 years old. He stands 4'3" and weighs 46.29 lbs. Thanyatsep who is fondly called "Jee-no", is a Thai and Buddhist boy. He can speak both Thai language and Northeastern dialect.

Jee-no and family live in Ban Gud-ra-ngum village, a small village located around 6 km from Warinchamrab district, and around 10 km from Ubon Ratchathani province. Some part of this village is slope area while some part is low land area situated around 2 km from Mool River, the main river of northeastern part of our country. There are 3 seasons, the temperature in summer is around 35-40 degree Celsius, it is around 10-15 degree Celsius in winter. There are flooding conditions occur around 20% of the village area in rainy season, especially in the low slope area near the river. There are around 967 populations or around 246 households in this village. It is convenient for people in traveling from the village to other places by motorcycles and buses. Most of villagers are children and working age persons. Since this village is in animal raising and military areas, the families cannot own the land, so they have no arable land and have only house building area. Main occupation of community members is general worker, average family annual income is around USD 2,500.- (USD 1=Baht 30). There is a public school and 1 Buddhist temple in this village. There is a public sub-district health promotion hospital located around 3 km from this village. Health problems found in this village are children's malnutrition caused of inappropriate physical developments per ages as well as physical and mental disabilities, seasonal diseases such as hemorrhagic fever, drug addiction problems, chronic diseases problems of the elderly persons i.e. high blood pressure and diabetes.

Jee-no is healthy, and has received vaccinations per schedules. He has good developments the same as other children. He eats 3 meals per day cooked by his maternal grandmother. Jee-no and family are benefited from government health insurance program.

Jee-no is a cute, polite, cheerful, responsible, and active boy. He is studying in grade 3 at a public school named Ban Gud-ra-ngum School, located around 2 km from his home. He goes to school and back home by motorcycle with his maternal grandfather. He receives USD 0.33 as daily allowance to school. He is benefited from school free lunch program for students. He is also benefited from School Farm Project to Help Unhealthy Children and Project To Support Laying Hens for Sustainable Income Generation to School and Households in Ban Gud-ra-ngum village supported by our foundation. He is kind and likes to help friends doing things. He likes to study and pays good attention in it. He can study in the good level. He got G.P.A. 3.89 from last semester exams. Mathematic is his favorite subject. He wishes to be a electric engineer when he grows up. Running race is his favorite sport. He can get along well with all friends. He likes to help with school's activities. He helps his family to sweep floor, and fill drinking water bottles. Red is his favorite color. In free time he likes to run for fun, play soccer and games with friends.

Your generous support is needed for Jee-no as it will assist him to have more readiness in studying, and more willpower in paying good attention in studying continuously to graduate from high educational level for better future of himself and his family. His family is very poor, earns very few and uncertain income per year that is not enough to cover family's living cost and children's education expenses. Without your kind support Jee-no may decide to drop schooling before he completes compulsory level in order to help his family working to earn income for supporting whole family.

We would like to introduce you to the other members of the family. They are:

Jee-no's parents separated. His father has neither visited nor sent cash support to him. His mother remarried and moved to stay with her new husband in another province, she visits him not often, she sends cash support around USD 10.00-16.66 a few times per year. Jee-no's grandfather, Mr. Suriya, is 54 years old. He earns monthly income around USD 150 as a daily worker as he has work to do around 15 days per month. His grandmother, Miss. Paeng, is 49 years old, she grows rice for family consumption, but the rice crops is not enough for eating in whole year, the family has to buy rice for cooking in some parts of year. Jee-no's aunt, Miss. Pornnapa, is 15 years old, and studying in year 1 of vocational level.

The family has lived in this community for many years. They stay in one storey concrete house with zinc roof belongs to grandfather. The house is in moderate condition. It has 1 bedroom, opened room, one kitchen, and one bathroom. The house has electricity and is furnished with an old television, electric fan, and light bulbs. There is village water supply system for using, they buy filter water bottles for drinking around USD 4-6 per month. Household garbage is disposed by burning several meters away from their home.

Like any other Thai family, Jee-no's family wishes to improve their quality of life. They dream of having their school age family members complete their education, enjoy good health, have a clean and orderly house, and most importantly increase their income.

Jee-no and his family need assistance, and your kind sponsorship will make a difference in their lives. Your support will usher in new hope and confidence in the family as they work together for a brighter future. Our foundation commits to facilitate a family development process for this family so they achieve lasting improvement in their lives. We implement programs on **H**Health, **E**ducation, **L**ivelihood and **P**sychosocial developments from which his family can benefit. We do this through the handed-up approach of partnership so families develop their self-help abilities to learn in building up what they can do with a little assistance, motivation and inspiration from generous sponsors like you.

Jee-no looks forward to communicating with you in Thai language (original letters will be attached with English translation letters), and sharing important family events with you and family in the future.
